RAPPORT

Briefly describe the project in a language understandable to non-scientists

The chronic inflammatory bowel diseases (IBD), Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis are becoming more common in childhood. Cancer and death may be associated with IBD, but are rare in children and adolescents. Data on this matter are sparse. The organisation of public health care system in the Nordic countries makes it possible to obtain high quality data regarding cancer and mortality in this age group. We plan to perform a retrospective study including the populations <18 years of Denmark and Finland, based on data from public health care registers

The project will be carried out by a PhD student. We have applied for funding for the PhD study from several sources and we expect to be able to launch the study by 01MAY2017 (to be completed by the end of 2018)
